<u>Investigators explore</u> <u>fearsome swamp known as...</u>

America's deadly triangle of terror

BIGFOOT, UFOs, a giant prehistoric bird with a 12-foot wingspan, and a huge killer dog with eyes of fire are all said to exist there.

And now one man is ready to unveil the horrors of the 5,000-acre Hockomock Swamp, deep in the heart of the deadly Bridgewater Triangle.

"It's a dangerous, evil place," paranormal investigator Joseph DeAndrade tells the EXAMINER. "I wouldn't waste my time doing this if there wasn't something strange going on."

In 1985, the 33-year-old security guard from Bridgewater, Massachusetts, formed the Bridgewater Triangle Expedition Team (BTET) after he claimed he saw a Bigfoot in the swamp.

Recalls DeAndrade: "It was very tall with long, dark brown hair.

"It walked just like Frankenstein. I didn't see its face since it was walk-

ing very slowly facing the opposite direction.

"I could only see the beast from the waist up."

DeAndrade says people hiking in the 200-squaremile triangle also claim to have seen a large black panther and a huge black snake as wide as a stovepipe.

"Some people even insist that satanists are conducting human sacrifices in the triangle after they heard horrifying screams of pain coming from deep in the heart of the swamp," he says.

Adds DeAndrade: "Several years ago, an expedition of Massachusetts archaeologists discovered an 8,000-year-old Indian burial site in the swamp on a place called Grassy Island.

"It was reported that when the graves were opened, the red clay within the tombs bubbled and dissolved, and every photo

And recently, according to DeAndrade, a huge dog with piercing red eyes jumped out in front of a speeding car near the Bridgewater Triangle and the car went right through the pooch!
